Thursday, 29 February 2024

This afternoon you travel from the South Burnett by coach for an overnight stay at Ibis Brisbane Airport.
(Dinner at own expense)

Day 1 – Friday, 1 March 2024 Depart Brisbane – Arrive Melbourne

- ° This morning board your morning flight to Melbourne.
- [°] Upon arrival into Melbourne your coach and driver will be waiting to greet you and introduce you to Victoria's capital city and what it has to offer.
- [°] Check into your accommodation at Oakwood Premier Melbourne located at the crossroads of Southbank, South Wharf and South Melbourne.
- ° This afternoon, enjoy a few hours free to explore the city.
- [°] Tonight, you will enjoy an amazing 4 course dinner upon the Spirit of Melbourne Cruising Restaurant. Enjoy delectable food whilst cruising down the Yarra River by night.

Day 2 – Saturday, 2 March 2024 Dandenong Ranges and Yarra Valley

- [°] Following breakfast, escape to the country on a day trip into the Dandenong Ranges and the Yarra Valley.
- * Your journey starts at Belgrave Station where you will climb aboard the well-preserved century old Puffing Billy steam train. Puffing Billy is one of the oldest steam trains in Australia. Enjoy fresh mountain air as you chug along through Sherbrooke Forest.
- * Travel across Puffing Billy's most famous landmark the iconic Trestle Bridge.



- [°] After a leisurely hour-long journey, you will arrive at Lakeside Station, situated within the picturesque Emerald Lake Park.
- [°] Spend time enjoying the facilities at Lakeside before boarding the coach for a scenic drive to the Yarra Valley, Victoria's most well-known wine region.
- [°] Stop at Rochford Winery where you will enjoy a two-course lunch and enjoy a 4-wine cellar door tasting before heading back into Melbourne City.

Day 3 – Sunday, 3 March 2024 Melbourne City Highlights

- [°] After breakfast, you will board your coach for a short city transfer to the iconic Melbourne Cricket Ground. Better known as the 'G' to the locals, the MCG is steeped in sporting history.
- * Enjoy a behind the scenes tour of the MCG, as well as entry to the Australian Sports Museum. The museum brings together the history of the MCG itself as well as over 3500 objects across 95+ sports.
- * This afternoon you will visit Captain Cooks Cottage in the beautiful Fitzroy Gardens.
- [°] From here you will journey via colourful St Kilda and the exclusive suburbs around Brighton.
- * The Brighton Bay Bathing Boxes are a must see. The 82 bathing boxes are unique and remain as they did over one hundred years ago.
- [°] This evening, enjoy a three-course dinner at The Meat & Wine Co in Southbank.

Day 4 – Monday, 4 March 2024 Phillip Island

- [°] After breakfast, you will set off on an adventure to Phillip Island.
- [°] Phillip Island is located about 90 minutes from Melbourne.
- [°] First stop is at the Koala Conservation Centre. Visitors can explore lush native bushland and see iconic Australian wildlife in their natural habitat.

The two elevated tree-top boardwalks bring you closer to the koalas as they go about their daily business of sleeping, eating and sleeping some more.

[°] Next is a visit to Churchill Island. Churchill Island has an important place in the history of Victoria being the first site of European settlement.




- Churchill Island houses a historic homestead and a working heritage farm which dates back to 1872.
- [°] At the Antarctic Journey which is a joint venture between National Parks and the World Wildlife Fund (Australia) you will learn stories of conservation, climate resilience and what lives in the deep. Immerse yourself in the breathtaking visual and sound experience with floor to ceiling footage of Antarctic wildlife and landscapes.
- [°] Enjoy dinner before heading to the famous Penguin Parade Viewing.

Day 5 – Tuesday, 5 March 2024 Great Ocean Road

- [°] Today we experience one of Victoria's most scenic drives The Great Ocean Road.
- [°] Today's road trip will take you from Melbourne to Torquay, home to some of Australia's best known surf beaches. Torquay marks the official beginning of the Great Ocean Road.
- [°] Coast views will dominate the 30 kilometres between Torquay and the beach town of Lorne. Lorne is located between the sparkling waters of Loutit Bay and the Otway National Park.
- [°] As you make your way to Apollo Bay, you'll travel up along cliff tops offering incredible views alongside wild beaches.
- [°] Lunch today will be at the Apollo Bay Hotel.
- [°] Get your camera ready for the spectacular coastline leading to Port Campbell and the famous 12 Apostles, a group of magnificent rock stacks rising up from the Southern Ocean. Enjoy the lookout over the cliffs of the Loch Ard Gorge and the beautiful Bay of Islands.
- [°] Continue along the Great Ocean Road west to Warrnambool which is your overnight destination.







Day 6 – Wednesday, 6 March 2024 Warrnambool to Ballarat

- [°] Following breakfast you will enjoy a visit to the Flagstaff Hill Maritime Village. Here lie the stories of hundreds of ships, their crewmen and passengers whose lives were claimed by the Shipwrecked Coast in the 19th Century. Stories passed on by the lucky few who survived the journey to start a new life in a foreign land, vowing never to set foot on a ship again.
- [°] Following your tour of the Maritime Village, you will then encounter Project Maremma! You will learn about the Little Penquins on Middle Island and how in a world first, Maremma dogs are being used to protect the penguin colony.
- Enjoy lunch at Flagstaff Hill before continuing your onward journey to Ballarat.

Overnight – Quality Inn Heritage on Lydiard Meal Inclusions – Continental Breakfast, Morning Tea and Lunch

Day 7 – Thursday, 7 March 2024 Ballarat to Melbourne

- ° Start your day with a continental breakfast at your accommodation.
- ° This morning you will visit Sovereign Hill.

Overnight – Oakwood Premier Melbourne Meal Inclusions – Breakfast and Dinner

- [°] Sovereign Hill presents the story of Ballarat as a gold rush boomtown. Ballarat began as a sheep farm, but following the discovery of gold in 1851, it triggered the great alluvial gold rush. The sleepy pastoral settlement grew rapidly into a fine provincial city built on the wealth derived from the gold.
- [°] The outdoor museum of Sovereign Hill enjoys international renown as a living museum featuring rare trades including wheelwrights, candlemakers and blacksmiths. There are also working machinery exhibits and costumed interpreters.
- [°] This afternoon, relax and enjoy the journey back into Melbourne in time for dinner.
